As RW Grand Lecturer (West) Larry T. Johnson, #298 held down the duties of Master of Ceremony (MC) with support from WADDGM James Parham, #290, RWSGD Antonio R. Pride, #43, and WADDGM Hozsa Bagley #17 who all involved in presenting the scripture, prayer, and welcome for the program. In the late 1950"s, the name was changed to the Most

Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Virginia Free & Accepted Masons, Incorporated. Rev. Brother George Lyons #43 and Pastor of Gillfield Baptist Church then gave a sermon from John 2:1-4 and preached to "Invite God In". After the Word, the ceremony of the wreath dedication was made at the church altar by Most Worshipful Grand Master Donald S. Wilson, #67 and RW Deputy Grand Master Beverly W. Morgan, #298 and the Brother proceeded outside to present the wreath at the headstone.
